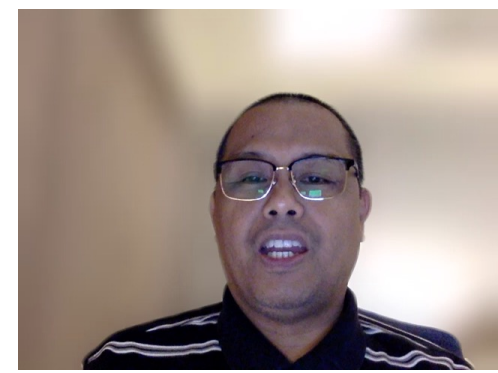


NRCP MANDATES (ACT 4120)

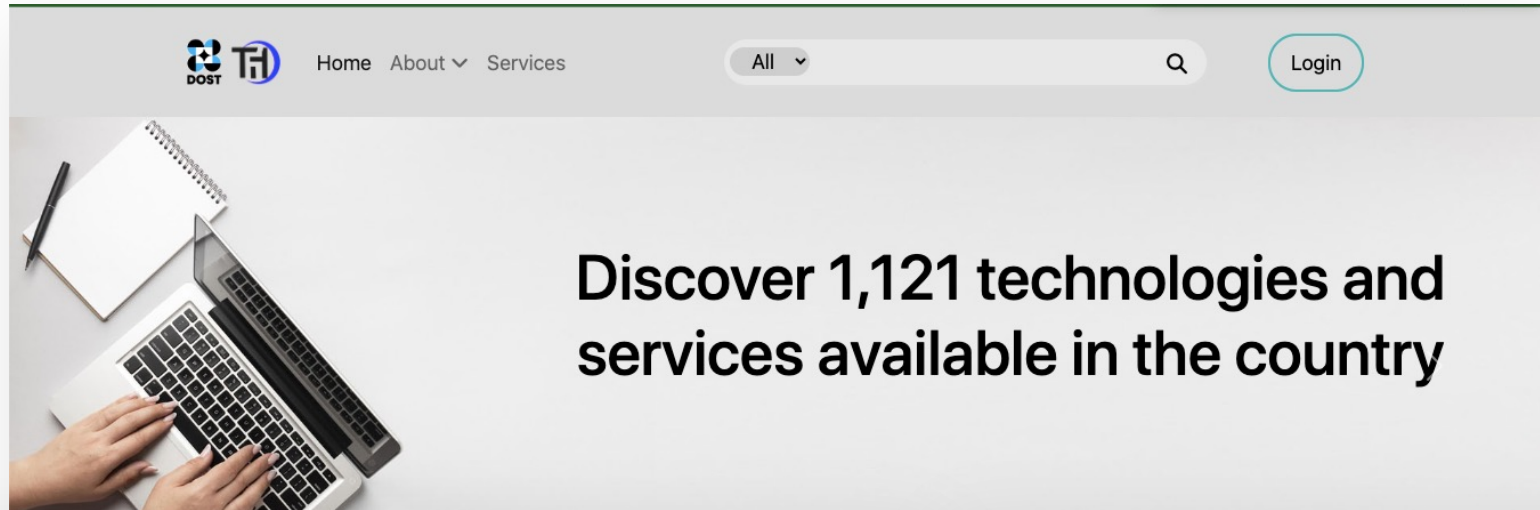
