The Philippine Educational Measurement and Evaluation Association (PEMEA) is pleased to invite you and your colleagues to its Continuing Professional Development Program (CPDP) on **Improving Tests to Assess 21st Century Skills**. This will be held on **May 18, 2019 from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm** at **St. Paul University Quezon City, Aurora Blvd. Cor. Gilmore Ave., Quezon City**.

This CPDP is a one-day seminar-workshop where participants will be trained on how to use the Revised Bloom's Taxonomy by Krathwohl and Anderson and the Structure of Learning Outcomes (SOLO) by Biggs and Collis in developing and evaluating students' 21st century skills. The session highlights the use of the cognitive processes and the knowledge dimensions in constructing quality test items using the multiple choice format in assessing students' 21st century learning skills. The target participants are teachers from the basic education to the tertiary level.

At the end of this CPDP, the participants are expected to (1) demonstrate understanding of the Revised Bloom's Taxonomy and SOLO in the construction of quality multiple choice items; (2) construct multiple choice items in assessing the 21st century skills; and (3) reflect on the importance of assessment framework in developing high quality cognitive tests.

The registration fee for the CPDP is Php 1,500.00, which covers workshop materials and lunch. You may register online through <http://bit.ly/21stcenturyassessment>. Registered participants can then pay through bank deposit.




