It will be held on **November 18, 2017** at the **Mapua University, Muralla St., Intramuros, Manila.**

The CPDP on Item Response Theory aims for the participants to: (1) Determine the uses of Item Response Theory for Scales; (2) Interpret data from scales using Item Response Theory; and (3) Use a statistical software to run Item Response theory. The seminar will be an opportunity for participants to think about the existing data bank and their plan to gather data and how they will use the Item Response theory for it. The workshop will start with an introduction about Item response theory for polytomous data, its features and advantages, aspects that needs to be interpreted, and running the analysis using a software. During the CPDP, participants need to bring their own laptop, pocket wifi, and extension cord. The trial software will be made available to the participants during the workshop.
